For Earth, For Life

Thame Town CC is a well-established cricket club in the County of Oxfordshire. Situated in the centre of the historic market town of Thame, the Club enjoys a picturesque setting at Church Meadow, as featured in the February 2019 edition of "The Cricketer".

The club was founded in 1874 and organised cricket has been played in the town ever since this date, apart from suspensions in 1914-1919 and 1940-1945. The Club moved to Church Meadow in 1975 and created both the cricket ground and the old pavilion, by converting the existing low-grade agricultural land and derelict farm-buildings. Finally, after a 5-year project of hard work and fundraising, the club were handed the keys to a brand-new clubhouse in October 2018, one of the facilities for cricket in the region.

The Club caters for committed and competitive adult and youth cricketers, men and women, from the age of 5 into their 70s, as well as those who enjoy only the occasional game. The club fields 4 men's league teams on a Saturday, plus a team playing midweek and Sunday friendlies. The 1st XI currently plays in the Home Counties Premier League (Div 2), while the 2nds, 3rds and 4th XIs play in the Cherwell League. Our second ground is at Lord Williams Upper School in Thame. As for junior cricket, we currently run teams in four age-groups in the Oxfordshire and Bucks leagues, plus an U17 side playing friendlies this season.

As for the Women's squad, they were Champions of Home Counties Division 2 last year and will now play in the newly-formed Premier Division this season, together with a number of hardball friendlies and softball tournaments (see page 26).

The Club is accredited to Clubmark and is recognised by the England and Wales Cricket Board as one of four "focus clubs" in South Oxfordshire, by virtue of its standards, youth coaching programmes, Clubmark status and the links with Lord Williams's School. We also host Oxfordshire 1st XI fixtures.

In 2022 we had almost 300 playing members, including 185 juniors, 22 women and 85 adult / student men, not to mention over 50 social and family members. We have 25 active, qualified coaches at different ECB levels (from CSW to Foundation and Level 2) including an overseas player/coach returning from Sri Lanka.

CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE - looking ahead to 2023

Looking ahead to 2023, we are focused on making it a more positive year for our teams in the Cherwell League, while also strengthening our women's and girl's sections. We have developed a 5-year club and performance strategy and have already initiated several steps, including a recruitment drive across the club, additional coaching for the women's team, working on strengthening the junior coaching set-up, entering an Oxfordshire girl's tournament, extending the junior pathway, working to grow sponsorship and commercial activities, and creating more publicity for the club and its teams.

This year we extend a warm welcome back to Farid, who made a positive impact on our players' enjoyment of the game with his coaching in 2022 and we are also delighted to announce that our overseas professional Dinny Malan is returning to Thame for 2023, bringing his wife Harshani. They both played key roles last year in the 1st and Women's XI respectively.

We have an ambition to grow the junior pathway, not just for those boys and girls with obvious talent, but also for those who show potential, and those who just want to improve at cricket. We already have a very strong roster of junior coaches and will look to enhance the offering to all junior cricketers by giving them plenty of opportunities to play in both their age group leagues as well as friendly inter-club matches. We will also be putting on occasional masterclasses, run by either 1st XI players or external coaches, to offer our junior players something a bit different.

We are very grateful for the work put in over the winter by coaches and parents who are helping to grow and develop girl's cricket at Thame. We want to provide a pipeline of talented girls for the women's team who have performed amazingly well over the last few years. To do this Steve Shaw and Andy Hobbs have taken on the challenge of entering Thame girls into an Oxfordshire tournament, as well as softball festivals against local clubs. Girls will also be able to play in mixed age group cricket as they have always done . We look forward to working with local schools and Oxfordshire Cricket to grow girl's cricket and we will be putting on girls-only training sessions in the nets on Friday nights. Further information will be available soon. We thank our sponsor Farol for helping specifically with funding for girl's cricket. If you have any questions or your daughter might be interested in playing cricket in a friendly and fun atmosphere, please contact girls-cricket@thamecricket.org.uk. Our picturesque ground is in demand as always; Oxfordshire are playing two T20 matches against Berkshire on the 1st May as well as a 3-day game in July. We very much enjoyed seeing county cricket back at Thame last year and look forward to more of it in the future. Also on display are the over 60s England and Australia teams playing in the over-60s Ashes. England vs Wales over-60s featured last year and the talent on display was impressive.



WOMEN'S & GIRLS' CRICKET

2022 was a huge season for the Thame Town Women's squad, as they not only won the Division 2 South title, but then beat Hitchin to become undisputed Div 2 champions, winning promotion to the new Home Counties Premier Division (PD).

Now comes another big season in 2023, as the Women step up to the newly-formed PD which has been reduced to 10 teams from the 12 last year. The League's plan is then to cut down to 8 teams, so at the end of this season 3 are expected to go down, with 1 being promoted from the division below, now called the "first division" (FD).

What's more, the players' stamina will be tested, with the PD now playing 40-over matches, against 35 in the FD and just 30 played last season!

The actual league season starts on 18th June at home v Moreton. Sarah's squad has also entered a T20 knockout competition which starts on 23rd April; plus there is a Super-8, development league that runs throughout May & early-June.

For all girls (over 14), beginners and occasional players, there will be a Softball festival for women and girls at Church Meadow, from 12-4pm, on Sunday 7th May - everyone is welcome to come along and have a go!

Given the wet weather in the first half of April, it looks likely that the Women's squad will begin their season on Sunday 23rd, with a T20 Cup match, away at Wootton Bassett. All support will be really welcome throughout this exciting season!!

- Understand that if an individual or group of young players feel they are not being treated in a manner that is acceptable, then you have a right to tell an adult either at the cricket club or outside the game.

Players should

- · Play because you want to do so, not to please coaches or parents
- Remember that skill development, fun and enjoyment are the most important parts of the game
- · Be attentive at all training and coaching sessions
- · Work equally hard for yourself and your team both will then benefit
- · Recognise good play by all players on your team and by your opponents
- Be a sportsman win or lose
- Play to the Laws of the Game and accept, without question, all umpires decisions
- Control your emotions. Verbal or physical abuse of team mates, opponents, or match
 officials is not acceptable
- Treat all players, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take advantage of any player.

Code of Conduct for Parents & Carers

It is vital to the well being of our cricket club that parents/carers take an active interest in it, and in the progress of their children. There is nothing more stimulating to young people than the thought that their efforts are appreciated. Whilst we are always looking for volunteers to assist in the running of the Club, and you will always be welcome, all we ask is your support. Through that you can be assured that we do take the welfare of our young players very seriously. Set out below is a code of conduct for the benefit of parents/carers. We instil in our young players the importance of playing the game fairly and respecting opponents, and that can be reinforced by parents/carers.

- · Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them
- Discourage unfair play
- Never argue with officials
- · Never force your child to participate in sport
- · Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performance of all
- NEVER punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept the official's decisions
- Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy their sport
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- · Verbal or physical abuse of Club Officials will not be tolerated.

Transgression of this code of conduct will be discussed at committee where a probable sanction would be termination of membership.
